About Philip Parr - Director

Alongside a wide-ranging freelance practice as director of theatre, opera and festivals, Philip is Artistic Director of Parrabbola, who make large scale community plays in the UK and across Europe, and Director of the York International Shakespeare Festival.

Theatre work has ranged from main house productions, to small scale rural touring, with a particular focus on site specific and promenade theatre and on Shakespeare.

Current Shakespeare productions include 'Henry V [man and monarch],' 'FEAST: a play in one cooking' - exploring Shakespeare's female characters, and 'Travel Shakes.' His production of 'Pericles Prince of Tyre' premiered in March at the Hungarian State Theatre Csiky Gergely in Timisoara and was selected for the 2024 National Theatre Festival.

Larger work has included site specific, promenade performances of 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' and 'Romeo and Juliet' for the Shakespeare Festival in Craiova, and 'Pericles' and 'The Winter's Tale' in Gdansk. His most recent large scale projects were a site-specific cross-border production of 'The Winter's Tale' which travelled between Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland, and 'Shake Fear | Break Walls' in Gdansk - an exploration of borders real and imagined with five European partners.

Philip is a founding council member of the European Shakespeare Festivals Network and in 2021 was elected Chairman. He is an elected Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts.

HENRY W Monarch and man Practical Details

Company of 2 - actor & director

This show plays best in a smaller studio space, with the audience on three sides (thrust stage).

If the audience does not have raked seating then they should be no more than two or three rows deep.





There is no recorded sound. A lighting operator is required but the plot and show are simple. An outline lighting plot is available.

We ask that you provide a stack of old newspapers about 1 metre high which we use as props and setting. Any newspaper will work.

Projection for subtitles should be to the back wall, behind and above the actor. A projector and computer are required, with an operator, and a rehearsal for timing.

All set and costume elements travel in one suitcase at least 25kg, which must be included in travel arrangements alongside a guaranteed carry-on for our 2 company members.

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Budget to be negotiated depending on arrangement
